### *A Mother's Story:*



My five year old daughter has been an outpatient at Brook Lane for over a year now. She started there as a patient in the Partial Hospitalization Program where she received excellent care and guidance. The program offered intensive therapeutic treatment for her during the day and then she returned home in the evening. She was in this program for about a week and now is seen occasionally as an outpatient by a child psychiatrist. I am thankful every day for the changes that this has brought to her, to my life and to my other children's lives. Without having help from these wonderful people and this fine institution, I do not know how I could have ever managed my daughter's care over the past year. I know that each and every person who has worked with us deserves an award for the work that they do for our children and families. Although I can not give out an award, I do want to say thank you for being there for us and for helping improve our lives.

# At the Heart of What We Do.... *Hope & Inspiration*



***Hospitalization*** – Sometimes the stress of life becomes overwhelming. The loss of a loved one, a divorce, anxiety, family stress or a job loss can lead to phobias, depression or mood disorders. The inpatient unit is our most intensive level of care and provides crisis stabilization in a safe and therapeutic environment for children, adolescents and adults. Patients receive round-the-clock nursing care and intensive clinical intervention from a multi-disciplinary treatment team.

***Outpatient Services*** – Because each patient's needs are unique, our team of mental health professionals works with each individual to establish a treatment plan. The plan may include therapy, medication checks, addictions counseling, and/or psychiatric evaluations. Services are available in Hagerstown and in Frederick.

***Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)*** - The PHP offers intensive therapeutic treatment in a less restrictive setting than inpatient care. It allows children or adolescents to attend a structured therapeutic program during the day and return home at night. The objective is to improve interpersonal functioning and coping skills through a variety of therapies and communication skill training.



***Laurel Hall School in Washington County and Frederick County*** - A special education program for elementary through high school students which provides a high level of classroom structure and an array of therapeutic treatments. Each student has an individual education plan as well as a behavior management plan. Staffed by certified special education teachers, behavioral specialists, clinical social workers and nurses, Laurel Hall establishes a learning environment for students with emotional and behavioral challenges.

***Pastoral Care*** – Our chaplain and pastoral counselors are available to inpatients, students and/or residents needing or requesting spiritual guidance or grief counseling. Counseling and support are also available to clergy and their families. Consultation is also offered on matters of church, ministry and mental health.



***Abundant Life Counseling*** – A special outpatient program designed for those seeking faith-based, professional counseling. Licensed clinical staff provide counseling within the framework of Biblical principles where the resources of one's faith are valued as important to the healing process. Treatment may include prayer and scriptural reference.

***Stone Bridge Transitional Care Home*** – This licensed residential program provides treatment for children and adolescents who are in crisis and temporarily without an appropriate place to stay. We provide housing, education, and intervention to facilitate the transition of the client from one setting to another.

# At the Heart of What We Do.... *Connecting*



Brook Lane is committed to serving our community as both a resource and an advocate for mental health issues. We enhance community awareness through seminars and presentations, support groups, a speaker's bureau, and educational materials. We partner with other organizations to foster a better understanding of mental health.

In partnership with Hagerstown Community College, and partially funded by the William and Sylvia Hunsberger Education Fund, Brook Lane provided professional seminars on "Post Traumatic Stress Disorder," "Depression in the Aging Population," "Ethics, Law and Professional Conduct," and "Anxiety Disorders." All seminars offer continuing education credits and are held locally.

Volunteers are an essential part of Brook Lane. Nearly 5,000 hours of volunteer time were donated to the programs at Brook Lane. These include tutors for our students, landscaping, fundraising, committee work, unit clerk assistants and clerical work.

Donors are greatly appreciated at Brook Lane. As a not-for-profit organization, additional resources are needed to support our continuum of mental health programs. Campaigns are ongoing to provide support for the following funds: building, benevolent, endowment, career development, Stone Bridge Transitional Care Home, and Laurel Hall School.



# At the Heart of What We Do.... *Volunteer ~ Intern ~ Staff*



Maria has a unique story. She loved being a teacher, and loved being around children. But Maria felt helpless when children were struggling emotionally. Often times she could identify what the problem might be; however, she was untrained to assist the child and family with treatment.

Wanting to do more for her students Maria decided to learn more about counseling and become more acquainted with the mental health field. She started by taking classes at Frostburg University and volunteering at Brook Lane.

Enjoying her time volunteering at Laurel Hall School, Maria made the decision to become a counselor. When it came time to do her internship, she quickly applied at Brook Lane and was accepted in the program. During her internship, she spent time in the inpatient unit at the hospital and at Laurel Hall School. This gave her a chance to work with children, adolescents and adults.

Today, Maria is a licensed graduate professional counselor (LGPC) and an employee at Brook Lane, working mornings at the hospital with children and adolescents and afternoons at the Meadowbrook outpatient program with clients of all ages.

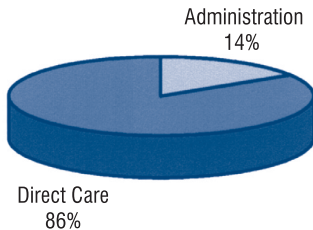

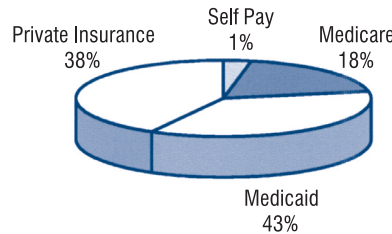

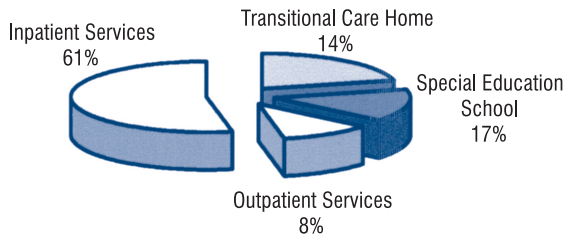
## Expenses\*
