Description:

This Seminar will present a comprehensive review of the diagnosis, treatment and current community resources for Autism Spectrum Disorder and Social Communication Disorder. Social Communication Disorder refers to individuals who have social communication and relationships deficits but do not meet full ASD criteria.

Comprehensive autism assessment will be explained including clinical interview, collateral information, diagnostic screenings and the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule-2 (ADOS-2).

Regional treatment and support resources will be reviewed including initiatives with Washington County Public Schools that may also provide guidance for other parents and school systems.

Finally, attendees will receive a toolbox of sensory/coaching/social skills techniques and training that therapists can incorporate in their practice to treat children/adults with ASD, those pending comprehensive ASD assessment and those who have diagnosed social and relationship deficits.

Participant Learning Objectives:

- Increased awareness of the prevalence of autism in Western Maryland and of available assessment, treatment and support services
- Review of the Individual Education Plan (IEP) process and the criteria of emotional disability and autism spectrum disorder to receive special education services
- Leave with basic tools to begin building ample therapeutic techniques to work with those displaying neurodivergent characteristics
- Have an understanding of applying different therapy modalities with tailored steps to engage clientele/students
